We want your child to...

- hold a pencil effectively to form recognisable letters.
- be able to move in different ways in response to music.
- be able to use simple tools such as scissors safely and with increasing control.

- use simple games on the computer.

What you can do to help...

- Talk to your child about the changing seasons – darker evenings and colder weather.
- Look at the stars and the moon and talk about space and the planets.
 - Sing favourite songs and carols together.
- Write lists for Christmas or letters to Santa, encouraging your child to write their names and sound out and write words.
 - Look for numbers and shapes while out.

- experiment with different materials and textures.
- use and mix different colours.
