COVID 19

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- a high temperature - this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough - this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste - this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Most people with coronavirus have at least 1 of these symptoms.

A quick reminder about pierced ears. We have a few children who are still unable to take their earrings out after having their ears pierced. If this is the case children need to have their ears covered (micro tape) in school & particularly for PE.

One of our parents has told us that you can buy clear plastic ear retainers on ebay or amazon very cheaply. These seem to really work and take away the need for micro-tape in school.
